2019 Ladies League Event Details

- Preseason, April 25th – Play a hole with the pro! Ryan will join each group during the play of a hole and you can ask questions about rules, etiquette, swing. Scramble format in which you can choose to play Ryan's tee shot.
- Blind 5 holes, May 2nd – Gross & Net; all 9 holes are played but only 5 holes are counted. The secret 5-holes that are counted are selected by the Golf Shop.
- Awesome!, May 9th – Team, Net; each player tees off, the most AWESOME tee shot is selected and each player hits her second shot from that location. Play your own ball until the ball is holed. Take the best score from the group. (one best ball counts)
- Crier's Day, May 16th – Gross; Gross score on your 3 worse holes is reverted to a par.
- 2-Lady 3-3-3, May 30th – Holes 1 thru 3, Best ball net; holes 4 thru 6 two-person scramble; holes 7 thru 9 Pinehurst alternate shot. In this format, both ladies tee off, pick the best ball of the two. Whoever's ball is picked, the other player will hit that ball and the ladies will alternate until the ball is holed.
- NTS, June 6th – Net Game; Net scores on the holes beginning with the letter's "N", "T", and "S" will be counted.
- Beat the Pro, June 13th – Net Game; Ladies will get their handicap, in an attempt to beat Heartland Crossings Head Golf Professional Ryan Maier!
- Evens & Odds, June 21st – Net Game; we will have a winner for the lowest score on the even numbered holes and a winner for the lowest score on the odd numbered holes.
- 2-Lady Scramble, June 27th – Net and Gross; two ladies will team up to play a scramble. We will have a gross winner and net winner.
- Cross Country, July 11th – Net Game; pick your best scores from holes 1 & 9, holes 2 & 8, holes 3 & 7, holes 4 & 6, and hole 5. Low net score wins.
- 2-Lady Pinehurst Alt shot, July 18th – Net Game; 2 ladies will team up in a version of alternate shot. Both ladies will tee off to start the hole. They will pick the best of the two shots to play and whoever's ball is picked, the other player will hit the second shot. The player who did not hit, will hit the third shot and repeat the process until the ball is holed.
- Hat'em, July 25th – Gross and Net; before the players tee off, each golfer is to circle two holes she absolutely HATES! Subtract the score from those two holes, good or bad. Low score wins!
- Club Championship, August 25th – Tee times following the last men's group. Winner for low gross and low net.
- Five times Two, August 15th – Team net; two best balls count on 5 predetermined holes and 1 best ball count on the remaining 4 holes. Golf shop will determine the 5 holes.
- Mystery Partner, August 22nd – Team Net; golf shop will randomly assign teams of 3 during the play of golf. Winners for low individual and low team.

Circle 5, August 29th – Net Game; before teeing off, each player circles 5 holes on her scorecard that will be used for that day's round.

Me Too!, September 5th – Each player will be given 4 “Me Toos” that are used to move their ball from its current location to that of another player's. It is similar to using a mulligan but instead of hitting a second ball from the same location, the ball is simply moved from its current position to that of another player's ball. The “Me Too” can be used any time, including drives, exiting the sand, or putting.

Par 3 contest, September 12th – Gross game; Ryan will go out before league play and set up each hole to play like a par 3. Par will be 27 for the 9-holes played. Lowest score wins!

Ladies Shoot-out, September 19th – All ladies will participate in a 3-hole shoot-out to determine a winner.
